and those present constituting a quorum of the Board for purposes of canvassing election results, the following was transacted:

**CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF THE MAY 2, 2026 ELECTION ON THE PROPOSITION OF THE ADOPTION OF AN INCREASED LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 10 (ALSO KNOWN AS THE MAGNOLIA FIRE DEPARTMENT) AT A RATE NOT TO EXCEED TWO PERCENT (2%) IN ANY LOCATION IN THE DISTRICT IN ACCORDANCE WITH HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE § 775.0752.**

Commissioner McDonald introduced an Order and made a Motion that the same be adopted. Commissioner Violette seconded the Motion for adoption of the Order. The Motion, carrying with it the adoption of the Order, prevailed by the following vote:

Commissioner Smith thereupon announced that the Motion had duly and lawfully carried and that the Order had been duly and lawfully adopted.

The Order thus adopted reads as follows:

**ORDER CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF THE MAY 2, 2026 ELECTION ON THE PROPOSITION OF THE ADOPTION OF AN INCREASED LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 10 (ALSO KNOWN AS THE MAGNOLIA FIRE DEPARTMENT) AT A RATE NOT TO EXCEED TWO PERCENT (2%) IN ANY LOCATION IN THE DISTRICT IN ACCORDANCE WITH HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE § 775.0752**

WHEREAS, Notice of this Meeting of the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners, has been given in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, at an election held on the 2nd day of May, 2026, in the District there was submitted to the qualified voters an election ballot on the Proposition for the adoption of an increased local sales and use tax in Montgomery County Emergency Services District No. 10 (also known as the Magnolia Fire Department) at a rate not to exceed two percent (2%) in any location in the district.

WHEREAS, at the election, **4,769** votes were cast in favor of the Proposition, and **2,214** votes were cast against the Proposition; and

WHEREAS, the Proposition of the adoption of an increased local sales and use tax in Montgomery County Emergency Services District No. 10 (also known as the Magnolia Fire Department) at a rate not to exceed two percent (2%) in any location in the district did receive the **affirmative** vote of the majority votes cast at the election as provided by law,

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ADJUGED AND DECREED BY THE BOARD OF EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMISSIONERS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 10, as follows:**


Section 1: The matters and facts recited in the preamble of this Order are found and determined to be true and correct; the Proposition to the adopt an increased local sales and use tax in Montgomery County Emergency Services District No. 10 (also known as the Magnolia Fire Department) at a rate not to exceed two percent (2%) in any location in the district, **passed** in a properly conducted election by the eligible voters of the District.

**ORDER OF THE BOARD OF EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMISSIONERS  
IMPOSING A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX  
IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 10**

IN OPEN MEETING on May 13, 2026 of the Board of **Emergency Services Commissioners of Montgomery County Emergency Services District No. 10** (the "District"), with the following Commissioners being in attendance:

✓Larry Smih, ✓Charles McDonald, ✓Kelly Violette, ✓Jeff Cunningham, ✓Todd Stephens

The Commissioners present constituting a quorum of the Board, considered the following MOTION made by Commissioner Cunningham and seconded by Commissioner McDonald to impose a local sales and use tax at a rate not to exceed two percent (2%) in any location in the District, as exemplified below. After discussion and consideration, the Motion and Order was adopted and approved by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 against; and

WHEREAS, following an election held on May 2, 2026, whereby the voters within the District approved the establishment and adoption of a sales and use tax of up to a maximum rate of two percent (2%); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 775 of the Health and Safety Code and pursuant to the Texas Tax Code, the District is authorized to adopt and impose a sales and use tax; and

WHEREAS, the District intends to impose a local sales and use tax within the District.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED and ORDERED that a local sales and use tax at a rate not to exceed two percent (2%) in any location in the District is hereby imposed pursuant to Chapter 775 of the Health and Safety Code and Chapter 323 of the Tax Code on all applicable sales and uses within the geographic boundaries of the District, excluding the areas where the existing local sales and use tax was already two percent (2%) as of the date of the election.
